Dear Ms Lawson

I am writing to ask if the Parish Council would continue to support Fellrunner for another year. We have been most grateful for your donations/grants in the past and have put the money to good use, maintaining our lifeline service to rural communities across the Eden valley and beyond. The past year has of course been a year like no other with services suspended and a severe loss of income. Nonetheless Fellrunner has responded by offering a service that brought shopping to the villagers rather than taking the villagers shopping. Our efforts in this and over the past forty years were recognized in the announcement of the Queens Award for Voluntary Service a few months ago.

Fellrunner is again running a full timetable and we are doing all we can to provide the services your parishioners need. Usually at this time we quote the number of passengers from your parish that have used the service during the year and suggest a donation /grant based on this. With the service off the road for a long period this would have no meaning this year so we have based the calculation on the figures for the last full year before the pandemic.

Based on our record of 628 passenger journeys made in your Parish during the reference year, your donation at 35p/journey would be £219.80.
